Course Description:

Public scrutiny of law enforcement operations is currently at unprecedented levels. This creates additional challenges for government auditors working to evaluate risks and conduct audit engagements related to law enforcement operations. Law enforcement audits differ from other governmental audits and can be hugely successful when performed in consideration of risks, procedures, and the culture unique to the law enforcement environment.
